



COLLABORATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN CENTRO DE MEDICINA TROPICAL, FACULTAD DE MEDICINA, UNIVERSIDAD NACIONAL AUTONOMA DE MEXICO AND POST GRADUATE PROGRAM IN HEALTH SCIENCES OF THE UNIVERSIDAD ESTATAL DE MONTES CLAROS

The Centro de Medicina Tropical of the Medical Faculty of UNAM and the Post Graduate Program in Health Sciences of the Universidad Estatal de Montes Claros agree to collaborate in studies on Tropical Medicine in order to promote academic formation and to impulse research projects. This collaboration will promote the formation of health professionals, students, teachers and strengthen bilateral research projects in Tropical Medicine.

Objetives

- I To promote academic exchange of students and teachers.
- II To generate collaborations in research projects.
- III To offer specialized courses for classroom-based and distance-learning for students of both institutions.

This agreement will enable classroom and distant courses on pathogens causing diverse tropical diseases, including their biological cycles, transmission mechanisms, host-parasite relations and eco-epidemiological scenarios. Revisions and up-grades on diagnostic methods, therapeutical innovations and preventive measures will be offered.

Research projects involving researchers and students from both institutions will generate a strong impulse on knowledge of diverse tropical diseases.
